In response to your request for ISSN (International Standard Serial Number), the National Serials Data Program has made the following prepublication assignment to your title(s) expected to be published in

To complete the ISSN application process, you must send us a sample issue of the published issue. If it is in a tangible format (print, CD-ROM, diskette, etc.). For online serials you must notify us that publication has begun and send us a URL which we can access to determine bibliographic information needed to complete our record for your serial. If you do not send a sample issue or surrogate after publication, your ISSN is subject to cancellation. Until we receive a published issue, your ISSN is only provisional and is not included in national and international databases of registered ISSN.

As part of the ISSN assignment process, we use your sample issue to create an official record of your serial for national and international ISSN databases. After we have completed your ISSN registration, we forward your sample issue to the Library's selection officers to be considered for addition to the Library's collections. Only sample issues receive this consideration. However, if it is impossible for you to send a sample issue, we will accept a surrogate consisting of photocopies of the cover, title page, and all other pages showing title or publishing information.

We are enclosing for your information Copyright Office Circular R7d, which describes mandatory deposit requirements under the United States Copyright Act. If you have further questions concerning copyright requirements, please contact the Copyright Office directly at 202-707-3000. Please note that sending your publications to other divisions of the Library of Congress on subscription or for copyright purposes does not eliminate NSDP's need to see a sample issue.

Thank you for your cooperation in aiding this important international effort.
